

Creating an election guide for younger students: Layout options

You and your partner must decide on the design for your guide. Creativity is encouraged, but remember that your goal is to teach others about the election – so don't get too crazy. Make sure all the important information is included before worrying about looks.

Here are some ideas. You may pick one of these if you wish:

1. Voter's pamphlet, made from normal sized paper, folded in thirds or fourths.
2. Poster
3. Comic book
4. Story book
5. Informational video
6. Play/skit (turn in a script)
7. Worksheet/workbook (like a lesson)
 - a. Math: word problems, or solving puzzles to match words to definitions
 - b. Word puzzles

Whatever you do, make sure that in the end there is something the other students can take with them. If you make a video, put it online or in another format you can give to the teacher.
